Lesson 1.1: God Made a Promise

The Big God Story began when God created the heavens, the earth, and everything in it. Adam and Eve were the very first people. They walked and talked with God until one day, they chose to disobey the Lord. Because they disobeyed God, Adam and Eve could not live in the garden anymore. Sadness and sin entered the world. But God had a plan. Before Adam and Eve left the garden, He made a promise—a very important promise! He promised to send a Savior to take away all of our sin. Jesus is the promised Savior.

Scripture has been provided for you to model to the children in your small group how to look for truth in Scripture. Some verses may be engaging for your preschoolers, while others may simply aid in your preparation to lead this time of discussion.

Questions:

1. Read Genesis 2:19-20a. **What job did God give Adam?** (He got to name the animals.)
2. Read Genesis 1:28. **What job did God give Adam, Eve and all of us?**
(The job of taking care of our world and everyone in it.)
3. Read Genesis 3:21. **How did God show love to Adam and Eve?** (Made clothes for them to wear.)
4. Read Genesis 3:15b. **God had a plan and made a promise to send a Savior. He made a way for us to be with Him forever. Who is the promised Savior?** (Jesus.)
5. **What part do you think you can play in The Big God Story?**
